

Instructions for installation in silent mode

The *silent mode* allows you to install the L-force software automatically in batch operation.

- ▶ All user entries usually queried during installation are transferred to the setup in a configuration file that must be created by the user.
- ▶ As template, you can find the configuration file "input.cfg" attached which contains all parameters in the form of `NAME=value` via which the setup can be configured.
 - For the meaning of the individual parameters, please see the comment lines beginning with the keyword **REM** in the configuration file.

Start parameters for the setup program

To start the installation in *silent mode*, start the installation program with the start parameter **/M** and indicate the configuration file used:

```
setup.exe /M=input.cfg
```

- ▶ With this call, the setup dialogs are visible throughout the installation and the installation process can be monitored.
- ▶ If necessary, the additional start parameter **/S** can be used to deactivate the setup dialog display:

```
setup.exe /S /M=input.cfg
```

- ▶ The configuration file must either be in the same directory like the installation program or be indicated with the complete path.
 - If the path contains spaces, it must start and end with inverted commas:

```
setup.exe /M="C:\My Documents\input.cfg"
```



Tip!

For a default installation of the »L-force Loader« in *silent mode*, you only have to call the setup program with the start parameter **/S**.

The configuration file "input.cfg" which you can find attached as template is only required for installations with target directories other than the default directories.
